This policy has been adapted to comply with the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) which will apply from 25th May 2018. Our Privacy Policy covers all Creative Interior Contracts Ltd (CIC) website users. CIC is registered in England number 3749511. We are committed to protecting your privacy and apply four principles which are detailed below.

Principal 1 – Notice
